

WAVE Project data use and protection policy

Preamble

The WAVE project (Workforce in Addictions · Valorisation in Europe), hereafter referred to as "WAVE", is co-funded by Grant No. 101045870 under the European Union's DG Justice Programme "Drugs Policy Initiatives - Supporting initiatives in the field of drugs policy" (JUST-DRUGS-AG) from 01/6/2022 until after the Lisbon Addictions 2024 Conference.

WAVE is collaborating with diverse expert stakeholders to review state-of-the-art evidence and good practice in relation to quality standards for the European addictions workforce, and to co-produce a track of the Lisbon Addictions 2024 conference (23-25 Oct 2024).

Data use and protection in WAVE

In compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament (GDPR), and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on data protection, Spanish Organic Law 3/2018, of 5 December, on protection of personal data and guarantee of digital rights, Spanish Law 34/2002, of July 11, on Services of the information society and electronic commerce, and, in accordance with other applicable legislation, we inform you that the entity responsible for the processing of the personal data you are providing through this questionnaire is the coordinating partner of the WAVE project - Spanish public consortium INSTITUT D'INVESTIGACIONS BIOMÈDIQUES AUGUST PI I SUNYER (hereinafter, "IDIBAPS"), previously the CLÍNIC FOUNDATION FOR BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH (FCRB).

The WAVE personnel in IDIBAPS will process your personal data only for purposes related to your voluntary participation in WAVE Community of Practice working groups, and the mapping and development of guidance on workforce training and occupational quality standards in addictions, under the WAVE project.

The legal basis that legitimizes the processing of data is your express consent.

IDIBAPS will keep your personal data as long as it remains relevant for the activities of the project, and not longer than two years after the end of the project.

Your personal data will not be transferred to any other party.

Your rights regarding the data
